Dear Chairman Erickson,

In accordance with the Cache County Council of Governments (CCCOG) requirement as part of Utah State Code 59-12-2217, please accept this formal recommendation of funding for 2018 using countywide, voter approved sales tax revenue collected for transportation capacity improvements.

On October 2, 2018 the CCCOG agreed to recommend to the Cache County Council funding in the amount of \$5,694,749 toward eligible roadway improvement projects in Cache County as outlined below. The funds are in hand and available. These projects were selected after completing the application and project prioritization process prescribed in the approved CCCOG bylaws.
