Farmington City is seeking a qualified person to fill the Associate City Planner position in its Community Development Department. Qualified applicants will have a Bachelor's Degree from an accredited college or university in Planning, Public Administration, Landscape Architecture or a related field and two years' experience, or have an equivalent combination of education and experience in a professional setting to perform the responsibilities listed on the job description.

Summary:

The Associate City Planner works closely with the public, Community Development Department staff, the Planning Commission, City Council, Board of Adjustment, Trails Committee, Historic Commission, and other City departments to ensure that proposals for new development in Farmington comply with all applicable City ordinances. The Associate City Planner helps the Community Development Director and the Planning Commission with long range planning projects and community development activities.
